Lewis, Head of Community at Hibernian Community Foundation, added "The Rework programme kindly shared office resources across to us here at Hibernian Community



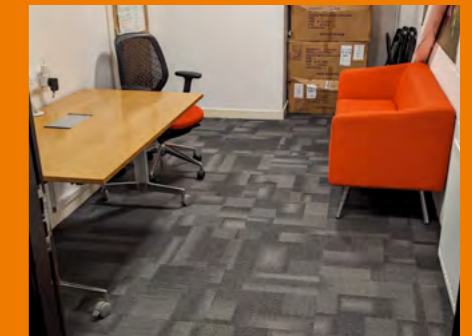
